

ESE Parent Survey

Parent Information Brevard Public Schools, Florida

The Florida Department of Education (DOE) is conducting a parent survey to give the Florida DOE and the United States Department of Education information on how well Florida's schools are supporting parent involvement in their child's special education and related services. This survey is for parents who have a child or children with an Individual Educational Plan (IEP).

The parent survey for the 2011/2012 school year will open February 1, 2012 and will close June 30, 2012. During this time, parents of students with disabilities will be able to complete an online survey regarding the special education and related services that are being provided to their child or children. Parents of children with disabilities, who are in preschool through grade 12, are being asked to complete this survey. The survey will be offered in both English and Spanish.

To complete the survey, please use a computer to go online to www.ESEsurvey.com. At that site you will be asked to select your child's school district (Brevard), your Child's school name, your child's current grade, and your child's birth date. Parents are asked to complete a separate survey for each of their children who have an IEP. If your child's IEP meeting is held between February 1, 2012 and June 30, 2012, you can request to complete the survey at the school after the IEP meeting. Please note that the DOE site is confidential and secure. None of the information that you provide will be linked to you or your child. If you complete the survey more than one time for a child, the site will allow you to complete the survey. However, only the input given in your first survey will be considered.

What?

The Florida Department of Education is conducting a survey designed to provide the state with information on how well schools are supporting parents' involvement in their child's education. Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), states must report this information to the federal government on an annual basis.

When?

February 1 through June 30, 2012.

Who?

All parents of children with disabilities and a current IEP in grades preschool to 12.

(Note: This survey is not intended for parents of students in the gifted program with educational plans (EPs).

How?

Go online to www.ESEsurvey.com to complete the survey.

Results?

Survey results are reported to the United States Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs, as part of Florida's Annual Performance Report and are posted on the Florida Department of Education's Website at www.fldoe.org/ese. Improvement activities are determined based on the survey report. Progress is monitored through the annual parent survey. No names will be released in any report. All responses are confidential.

What can you do?

The responses to the survey provide important information for planning and monitoring improvement activities. This survey, conducted once a year, provides parents with a unique opportunity to be heard.
